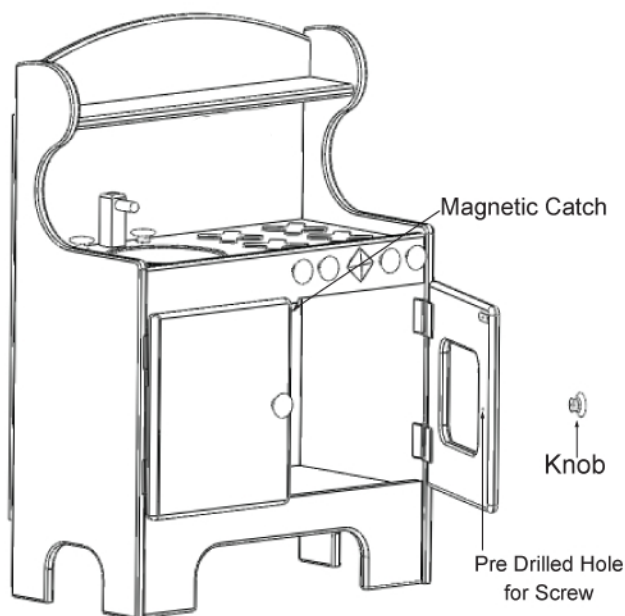
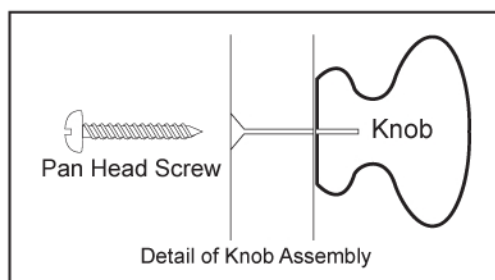

Assembly Instructions for Kitchen Item # 92

Contents:

1- Kitchen, 1- Sink, 2- Door Knobs, 2- 1 3/8" Screws

1- Anti tip-over kit



1. Open doors of Kitchen
2. Knobs are already attached to doors but are backward for shipping. Using a Phillips head screwdriver, remove the Knobs from both doors and reverse them.
8. Check the magnetic catch for proper adjustment so that both doors open with a child's minimal effort. Please make certain that a child does not need to use excessive force to open the doors. This could cause the Kitchen to accidentally be tipped forward if pulled too hard. The magnetic catch is easy to adjust by loosening the screws and repositioning them if not strong enough. If too strong, you can either adjust them or place a few layers of clear tape over the magnet to weaken the magnetic hold. The metal strikes on the doors are not designed to make full contact with the magnets (otherwise they would be too strong). A small portion of the strike contacting the magnet is sufficient.
9. The Sink is taped to the inside of the Left Door for shipping. To install simply place bowl inside the round cut out in the counter top area.
11. The anti tip-over kit should be installed by following the instructions included with the kit.
12. Please recycle or responsibly dispose of the plastic bag so that it will never be in contact with small children. There is an extreme risk of suffocation when children play with plastic bags.

Clear finish it is easy to clean with common non abrasive household cleaners. Do not use any cleaner that contains ammonia, such as Windex. All of our paints are made in America and are safe for children. The window is safe for children since it is made from shatter proof acrylic.
